5. National symbol of the United States of America

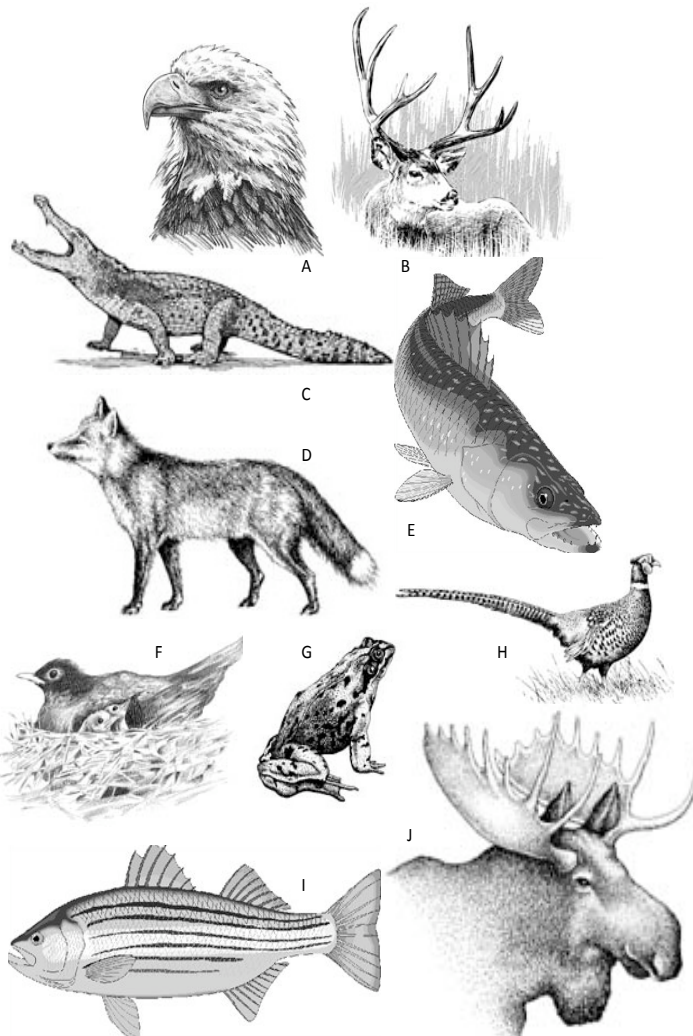
6. Largest member of the deer family
